



Neighbourhood Planning Sub-group: Meeting 18 14th May 2015, 7:00pm, Wray Institute

Minutes

- 1. Apologies – Jon Ingram, Cath Halstead, Eddy Taylor
- 2. Minutes – of the last meeting 16th April 2015, were read and agreed as a true record.
- 3. Declaration of interests – None.
- 4. Survey results – Eddy still awaiting some information from local businesses.
- 5. Opinion survey – this has been delivered and collected, was mentioned that collecting the surveys in was more difficult this time. Andy has 90 completed surveys which he has compiled into a spreadsheet for further analysis.
Andy commented on a few points that stood out from the surveys – residents found that parking was one of the major issues and ideas were put forward as to how this can be improved. Rivers were one of the most important feature residents wanted protecting, residents were in favour of limited small scale development. Hydro power also proved popular, the question on living space proved to be quite ambiguous.
Wray Fair survey – Corinne has collected the results from those who conducted on the spot surveys over Wray Fair and will report back at the next meeting.

- 7. Consultation – Every group has now been spoken too and is aware of the plan, although Corinne is still waiting to meet with Middlewood and the Institute Committee.

8. Next stage – Robert has applied for the next round of funding, a query has been raised on the application and this has been answered so hopefully there should be no problem in receiving the grant. Jennifer Milligan and Paul Hatch would like to attend a future meeting of the NPG; they are currently receiving minutes from the meetings. The draft plan should hopefully be in place by Oct/Nov. Awaiting information from local Business's, Robert to speak to Cath.

9. AOB – A thanks to be put in the Wrayly Mail by Carol, thanking everyone for completing the surveys.

It was discussed that in the first grant application it was said that we would have a Village event, so everyone can see where we are up to; this could also be used for residents to give their opinions as to where any further development should be sited.

Andy suggested this take place at the beginning of summer to allow time to compile the draft plan.

The afternoon of the 4th July has been put forward as a date for the event to take place, depending on the institute's availability.

Cath has a copy of a completed plan, which is being photocopied for the next meeting.
